The most popular class to compete in was the Expert-Open class touting 3 prize groups. Gary "GJ" Whittaker also nabbed the coveted first place trophy. Javier Media also racing for Nuttin 2 Lose came a close second with a time of 1 hour and 38 minutes to garner second place and Scott Hydes racing for Wes-Tec earned third place with a time of 1 hour and 40 minutes.

The Amateur trophy went to Kaleb Ebanks racing for Wes-Tec with an impressive time of 1 hour and 36 minutes.

The fan favorite and most closely watched race, Rookie, introduced the next generation of jet ski champion as Benjamin Cupid racing for Nuttin 2 Lose captured first place with a time of 1 hour and 43 minutes to a very enthusiastic crowd.
