JAC JUNE 18, 2013 – RULES & REGULATIONS – Revised 7/06/2013

REGISTRATION

The new registration deadline for JAC 2013 is Wednesday, June 26th 2013. A one-time early registration discount of 10% will be offered for non-CIWA members and a 15% discount will be offered for CIWA members who register on or before June 19, 2013. No discounts will be applied after this date. Registration and waiver forms may be submitted to Monster Media offices, 21 Eclipse Drive, Rankin's Plaza or emailed to julia.simmons@paramountmedia.ky. Fees must be submitted with registration and waiver forms. Call 949-8423 for details. No discounts will be applied after this date. Enquire for more information on cash prizes. ALL CLASSES ARE OPEN FOR CAYMANIAN RESIDENTS TO ENTER. Overseas riders can only enter the Expert-Open Class.

Expert-Open Class

- The registration fee for the Expert-Open Division is CI \$300.00.
- Riders classed as "Pro' by IJSBA or APBA regulations can only enter in the Expert-Open class.
- A minimum of 8 riders is required for the Expert-Open Class.

Rookie Stock Class

- The registration fee for rookies is CI \$300.00.
- Rookies must not have ridden in or finished a Jet Around Cayman race ever before.
- Rookies must ride a stock Jet Ski craft. This means use of aftermarket ECU is allowed but no performance improvement bolt-on engine parts or internal engine (including porting) is allowed. If there are concerns raised, your jet ski may be inspected by a JAC official before or after the race.
- A minimum of 5 riders is required for the Rookie Stock Class.

Amateur Open Class

- The registration fee for amateur riders is CI \$300.00.
- A minimum of 5 riders is required for the Amateur Open Class

NOTE:

• Any riders found using a craft which does not comply with this rule will be immediately disqualified and banned from participating in Jet Around Cayman 2014. Any prizes/titles won will be issued to the rider that placed next.

RACE DAY SCHEDULE

The following is the race day schedule for Jet Around Cayman 2013 on Saturday, June 29, 2013 at Surfside Beach Restaurant & Bar (subject to change):

9:00AM – Riders Check-In 10:00 AM – Technical/Safety Inspection 11:00AM – Riders Meeting 12:45PM – Pre-Start Line-Up 1:00PM – Official Race Start 3:00PM – Official Race Closure

LE MANS START

- Jet Around Cayman 2013 will feature a Le Mans start.
- Racers will assemble in a line across the beach with race gear on and lanyards in hand, one holder will hold the watercraft next to the beach line in front of the racer, at the sound of the gun racers will run down the beach, jump onto their crafts, insert the lanyard, crank up their engines and motor away towards the buoy making a right hand turn entering the race course towards Northwest Point area.
- Any watercraft spotted with a lanyard plugged in prior to the sound of the gun will immediately be Disqualified.

PIT STOPS

- There will be three pit stops throughout the course.
- All racers MUST stop to check-in at each pit-stop and circle the buoy, whether refueling or not.
- The pit stops are located at:
 - 1. North Side Over The Edge Bar
 - 2. East End Dock
 - 3. South Sound Dock and Boat Ramp
- At least one team member is required to attend the mandatory meeting. If representatives of a team fail to attend the meeting, they may not be eligible to race or receive the rider's package (depending on availability). Overseas and professional riders will be allowed to race as long as a team member notifies a JAC official of their participation at the mandatory meeting.
- Riders eligible for the Rookie Stock Class may also enter the Amateur division. Riders that are eligible for multiple classes and pay the required fees will have the opportunity to win all first-place prizes in the registered divisions. (Rookie, Amateur). Registration must reflect all entries.
- A team consists of 3 people with the option of having one rider and two support members or two riders and one support member.
- A mandatory pre-race riders meeting and Registration will be held: Wednesday, June 26, 2013, 6.30pm. @ (TBD). Please call 949-8423 for more information.
- THERE WILL BE ABSOLUTELY NO REFUNDS AT ANY TIME.



RIDER EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Numbers on both sides
- ✓ Numbers must be visible from 30 feet away
- ✓ Wet suit shorts, or half body suits
- ✓ Eye Protection
- ✓ Gloves
- ✓ Rope
- ✓ Cell Phone
- Fuel containers are the responsibility of the team and MUST meet the legal standards.
- The use of NOS is NOT allowed and any use will result in immediate disqualification and banning from participation in Jet Around Cayman 2014.
- Alcohol consumption is strongly prohibited. Any rider, team member or pit attendant found drinking will result in disqualification.
- There will be a section of the beach designated to the riders and teams. Each team is allowed space for one 10 x10 tent, but you need to inform the JAC committee ahead of time so that we may allocate the space. It is the responsibility of the team or rider to provide your own tent.

RACING REGULATIONS

- When racing, ALWAYS stay outside the 200-yard markers. When inside the 200-yard markers, remember speed MUST NOT exceed 5 knots NO WAKE ALLOWED!
- NO ONE is to pass the pace boat at any stage prior to the start of the race.
- Monster Media strongly recommends the use of helmets. Helmets are, however, not mandatory. They are optional.
- Racers must circle the buoys at each pit stop.
- Racers MUST keep a distance of at least 50 feet from any other craft on the water AT ALL TIMES!
- All support boats, MUST stay off 50 feet ocean side from all other crafts.
- No cutting in front of other racing crafts or boats
- No personal boats will be allowed to accompany riders.
- All decisions made by the Race Marshal(s) are final.
- A raised Yellow flag is a signal of caution. Riders are to continue at a slow pace and beware of hazards.
- There is NO over taking when the Yellow Flag is raised.
- Riders are not to ride 'on the reef' at any time during the Jet Around Cayman race.
- All racers MUST enter the pit stops through the channel markers and go completely around buoys. Course will be explained in more detail at the rider's meeting. If a rider fails to check-in at a pit stop or <u>do not</u> go completely around the buoy, they will be disqualified.
- Once through the channel markers, at North Side and East End, speeds MUST NOT exceed 5 knots NO WAKE. Because the South Sound channel markers are further out, riders can maintain their speed up to a large buoy, which will then indicate where they are to slow down to 5 knots or less.

- The pit stop marshal will sound a horn and raise a yellow flag to announce riders exceeding 5 knots. This flag will serve as a warning to all riders.
- The pit stop marshal will raise a red flag to signal a rider being penalized for exceeding 5 knots. This will only occur after a yellow flag has been raised to warn the rider.
- If a rider fails to see the raising of the flag(s), the penalization will still be enforced. It is not the fault of the marshal if a rider fails to see the warning or the penalization.
- Racers are to keep control of their craft at all times in the pit stops.
- Failure to do so can also result in being charged by the law.
- If a racer is unable to make it to the first pit stop, or any pit thereafter, for any reason, the rider must call into Headquarters to let them know that they are ok. A contact sheet with relevant names and phone numbers will be given to each rider before the start of the race.

ETHICAL BEHAVIOR

- Competitors will always act in a dignified manner with good sportsman-like behavior.
- Competitors will treat other competitors in the manner in which they would like to be treated.
- Acts of violence and intimidation against Organizers, Adjudicators or competitors will not be tolerated on or off the premises at any time during the event.
- Anyone failing to comply with the above, including team members, managers, and family, will result in immediate rider disqualification.

FINISH MARKER

- Once a racer has passed through the marked finish line, they MUST slow their craft to 5 knots or less.
- They MUST also return to one of the two-start/finish boats and to the timekeeper to check off both rider and craft.
- Upon reaching the shore, the rider MUST then report to the official on the beach. Please ensure that crafts are properly attended to at all times.
- All racers MUST check in at race headquarters at the end of the race.
- If, for some reason, a racer is unable to complete the race he/she must call into race Headquarters to inform them of the situation.
- Numbers to call for more information Kenny Rankin: 916-3724, Office 949-8423. More information will be given at the riders' meeting.
- If a racer who has completed the race has not checked with Headquarters within 15 minutes of crossing the finish line, it can result in their forfeiture from the race.
- Should a rider not complete the race, and not check in, they will not be allowed to enter JAC 2014.
- Any rider found by an official Jet Around Cayman marshal to be riding within 50 yards of the reef will be subject to disqualification, pending the review of the Chief Race Marshal.

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

Saturday, June 29th, 2013 the Jet Around Cayman race will commence starting promptly at 1pm at Surfside Beach Restaurant & Bar heading north. This race will be going completely around the island and will not be done until 3pm. Riders will obey all marine laws and will take into consideration of all dive sites. This is a warning for anyone that will be diving outside of the dive areas. The jet skis will be exceeding 60mph. This is an official warning.
